Flute supplies:

Polishing cloth

Cleaning rod - included with flute, unless lost over time

Oboe supplies:

Silk swab - has a string on both ends

Reed case - some hold 3, some hold more



Oboe reeds:

M. Lesher reeds (soft for beginners, medium soft to medium for older players)



Emerald reeds (soft and medium soft for beginners; would not recommend for players in junior and senior high)

Clarinet supplies:

Clarinet swab - can be cotton or silk Cork grease - Chapstick style works best Plastic reed case - can hold 2-4 reeds








Clarinet reeds (typically box of 10):

Juno, size $2\frac{1}{2}$ - for elementary band Juno, size 3 - for junior high and early senior high







LaVoz, size medium - for junior high and early senior high LaVoz, size medium hard - for senior high Vandoren (blue box), size 2 ½ or 3 - for advanced senior high

Bass Clarinet reeds: LaVoz medium or Rico 3

Saxophone supplies:

Saxophone swab - I recommend buying a cotton bass clarinet swab, because it will not get stuck in the horn

Cork grease - Chapstick style works best Plastic reed case - can hold 2-4 reeds Neck strap - available in many styles







Saxophone reeds:

Juno, size 2 ½ - for elem band LaVoz, size medium soft - for elem band and some junior high LaVoz, size medium - for junior high and senior high Vandoren (blue box), size 2 ½ - for most senior high







Trumpet/baritone/tuba supplies:

Valve oil: there are options!

"Cheap" valve oil (works)

"Better" Blue juice





Trombone supplies:

Slide oil



Slide grease



Slide-o-max (the best)
