

Instrument Kits for Music Class



Due to not being able to share classroom instruments in our music classes this fall, each student will be making an instrument kit of their own that we will be using in class. This week we will be learning about sound and categories of sounds. Students will be asked to try to find objects that they can make specific sound with (FOUND SOUNDS).

Each instrument kit will need:

DRUM: All objects will need to fit into a coffee can with lid for grades K-3 and an ice cream bucket with lid for grades 4-6.

WOODS/Rhythm sticks: pencils, small dowel cut to fit in container, chopsticks, wooden skewer (tips cut off), old drum sticks, etc.

SHAKER: plastic Easter egg or small McDonalds milk jug with rice, popcorn, or bean inside. (Other small object will work too, be creative!!!)

SCRAPER: we will need an object that can be scraped with another object or rubbed together to make a scrapping sound. Ex: ribbed tubbing scrapped with a pencil or pool noodles cut 3" and in half. We are looking forward to your creativity on this one!!

PLEASE DO NOT USE GLASS ITEMS

***Bring your instrument kit items to school on <u>Monday</u>, <u>September 21</u>. If you aren't able to find specific instruments, we will finish making the kits in class that week with items donated by the community.
